ABOUT YOUR VISIT

During your visit to Somerset Career Academy, you will have the opportunity to spend the day exploring skilled-trade career programs and shadowing a Career Academy student. You will learn what it is like to be a student in a career and technical education (CTE) program, see hands-on projects and equipment, and discover how classroom learning connects to real-world careers.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The CTE Trades Program provides students with hands-on training in skilled trades while developing technical skills, workplace safety, problem-solving, teamwork, and career readiness. Students gain practical experience through projects that connect classroom learning to real-world construction and industry careers.

CARPENTRY

Students learn basic construction skills, including construction math, measuring, cutting, framing, assembly, tool use, and finishing. The program emphasizes safety, craftsmanship, and hands-on learning.

ELECTRICAL

Students are introduced to electrical safety, wiring, circuitry, tools, and basic electrical systems. The program develops technical skills and prepares students for entry-level electrical careers and further training.

WELDING

Students learn about welding safety, metal preparation, equipment operation, and basic welding techniques. The program builds precision, fabrication, and problem-solving skills for careers in welding and manufacturing.
